Errata Note



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An error affecting 2 rows in each of Table 3A and 3B within the *NCMP England, 2010/11 Online Tables* excel workbook have been identified. These are:

Table 3A - Prevalence of underweight, healthy weight, overweight and obese children, with associated 95% confidence intervals, by Government Office Region, Local Authority County/Unitary Authority and Local Authority District/Formal District (derived from the postcode of the school), England, 2010/11

and

Table 3B - Prevalence of underweight, healthy weight, overweight and obese children, with associated 95% confidence intervals, by Government Office Region, Local Authority County/Unitary Authority and Local Authority District/Formal District (derived from the postcode of the child's residence), England, 2010/11

The errors affect figures for Central Bedfordshire Unitary Authority (row 216 in each table) and Cornwall Unitary Authority (row 385 in each table). The errors do not affect England level figures or data shown for any breakdowns within other tables. The pdf report - *NCMP England, 2010/11 Report* - is unaffected.

The original and corrected versions of the affected rows within Tables 3A and 3B are presented below. For clarity, the affected cells in the originally published version of each table have been shaded.

The *NCMP England, 2010/11 Online Tables* excel workbook has been re-issued. Tables 3A and 3B of the workbook have the corrected figures and also include revised footnotes.
