Background

The current release of DAPB4013 Medicine and Allergy/Intolerance Data Transfer was published on 30 September 2021.

Since then, the need for a minor correction to one requirement of the standard has been identified. A summary is provided below.

Note that an updated Requirements Specification has been issued and should be read in conjunction with this Corrigendum.

Summary

Requirement 6 (R6) and the corresponding conformance criteria, in section 5.1 *User (provider) requirements and conformance criteria* of the Requirements Specification, have been changed from:

Requirement	Conformance criteria
Providers SHOULD work with their IT system suppliers to complete the NHS Digital Risk Assessment for Assurance and Clinical Safety, which is part of the NHS Digital Interoperable Medicine Standards Assurance Toolkit. The Risk Assessment for Assurance and Clinical Safety SHOULD be completed and returned to NHS Digital Solution Assurance before any new API is used to transfer live patient data. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> NHS Digital's assurance guidance related to this Standard. 	NHS Digital's assurance guidance related to this Standard. NHS Digital Solution Assurance will provide sign-off that the risk assessment has been reviewed.

Requirement	Conformance criteria
Providers SHOULD work with their IT system suppliers to complete a local risk and clinical safety assessment before any new API is used to transfer live patient data. Some risks for consideration can be found in the self-assurance guidance and these should be used alongside existing governance already in place within your organisation.	A self-assessment should be completed between the IT system supplier and the provider to ensure all risks have suitable mitigations in place and are agreed between both parties.

This correction has been made to reflect a change in the NHS Digital Solution Assurance process.

In addition to the change above, a new hyperlink has been added to section 3.1 of the Requirements Specification as an editorial amendment. This change does not affect the content of the standard and is not itemised in this corrigendum.
